## APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Applications must include the following:

1. The completed application form (please fill out the form, print and sign it before submitting it as a scanned PDF document).
2. A cover letter providing evidence of the quality of the candidate's scholarship and expertise.
3. A description of the research project or the book envisaged as the outcome of the professorship; Candidates should state the objectives of their research, outline their methodology and describe the significance of their research for the field of education for sustainable peace. The description should also provide an indication of expected research results and how the candidate plans to disseminate these.
4. A full curriculum vitae with publication list.
5. A sample of the applicant's current scholarly writing (e.g. a book chapter or article).

## SUBMISSION INFORMATION

Application materials must be received by **October 1**. Submissions should be made electronically. All documents must be in one PDF file and the file size must not exceed 2 MB. The **file name** should be: Last name, First name\_Application Arnhold. Please send your application to [arnhold\[at\]gei.de](mailto:arnhold[at]gei.de).

## APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process consists of three phases:

1. Review of applications by a committee from the Georg Eckert Institute,
2. Evaluation of applications of preselected candidates by scholarly experts in the field of peace education,
3. Final selection by the academic advisory board of the program.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

The principal criteria for the committee's decision will be the candidates' academic reputation and the quality of the project envisaged for their sabbatical in Germany. In order to gain a clear idea of the candidates' ability to disseminate, communicate and achieve the objectives of their projects the selection committee will invite a number of candidates to an **online video interview** in the spring following the application deadline.

Candidates are responsible for obtaining a passport and any visa that might be required as well as for arranging health insurance for the duration of their stay in Germany.


