## GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE INTERNATIONAL SUMMER CONFERENCE

The Summer Conference brings together experienced academics, junior researchers and practitioners working in the field of education for sustainable peace and provides an opportunity to thoroughly discuss ideas, theories and methods of your work.

The Summer Conference primarily welcomes applications from doctoral candidates and post-doctoral scholars from the humanities and social sciences, particularly education, history, political sciences, sociology, law, anthropology, and psychology. Practitioners working for international organizations and NGOs in the relevant fields are also welcome to apply. Applications from students enrolled in a Master's program and recent graduates with a Master's degree will be considered in exceptional cases.

Part of the Summer Conference is an **incubator** session organized and facilitated by the [Airbel Impact Lab](#), which is the research and innovation arm of the [International Rescue Committee \(IRC\)](#). This day-long session will take place as part of the conference in order to explore connections between the IRC's work and the academic efforts of researchers selected to attend. The conference participants will use design methods and mindsets to think through practical ways of improving the impact of their work and/or increasing its application. It will also help identify synergies between researchers' work, and IRC programming.

Up to 5 individuals will be selected to undertake fellowships with the IRC. These individuals will travel to one of IRC's field locations for about 2 weeks, and work closely with IRC staff to undertake work which furthers both the IRC's and the fellows' interests.

**All attendees of the summer conference will be welcome to join the incubator and will be**

**eligible for selection to participate in this fellowship with the IRC.**




